The following conditions constitute and automatic fail of the IB Diploma as of May 2015:

- 1. CAS requirements have not been met.
- 2. Candidate's total points are fewer than 24.
- 3. An N has been given for theory of knowledge, extended essay or for a contributing subject (usually as a result of academic malpractice or failure to submit work).
- 4. A grade E has been awarded for one or both of theory of knowledge and the extended essay.
- 5. There is a grade 1awarded in a subject/level.
- 6. Grade 2 has been awarded three or more times (HL or SL).
- 7. Grade 3 or below has been awarded four or more times (HL or SL).
- 8. Candidate has gained fewer than 12 points on HL subjects (for candidates who register for four HL subjects, the three highest grades count).
- 9. Candidate has gained fewer than 9 points on SL subjects (candidates who register for two SL subjects must gain at least 5 points at SL).
- 10. A maximum of three examination sessions is allowed in which to satisfy the requirements for the award of the IB Diploma.
